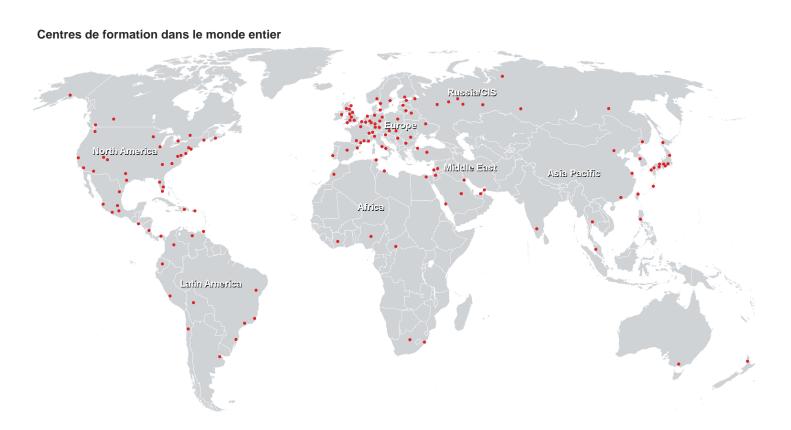

Details

- Exam name SAFe® 6 Product Owner/Product Manager Exam
- Exam format Multiple choice , multiple response
- Exam delivery Web-based (single-browser), closed book, no outside assistance, timed
- Exam access Candidates can access to the exam within the SAFe Community Platform upon completion of your SAFe® Product Owner/Product Manager course.
- Exam duration Once the exam begins, candidates have 90 minutes (1.5 hours) to complete the exam.
- Number of questions 45
- Passing score 80%
- Language English
- Exam cost First exam attempt is included as part of the course registration fee if the exam is taken within 30 days of course completion. Each retake attempt costs US?\$ 50,-.
- Retake policy Second attempt on exam (first retake) can be done immediately after first attempt. Third attempt requires a 10-day wait. Fourth attempt requires a 30-day wait. All subsequent retakes require a 30-day wait.
